RE: <u>Mandatory COVID-19 Testing</u>

DATE: August 12, 2021

Due to the number of positive cases of COVID-19 recently confirmed within the Capitol, <u>all Assembly employees</u>, <u>regardless of vaccination status</u>, <u>coming to work in the Capitol or LOB</u>, <u>must test this Sunday</u>, <u>August 15</u>, <u>unless they test in the Capitol Health Services Clinic in the Eureka Room today (Thursday) or tomorrow (Friday)</u>. In order to make testing as convenient as possible, we have added an additional testing time this afternoon.

## ALL STAFF MUST BE TESTED PRIOR TO COMING TO WORK MONDAY, AUGUST 16

Testing will take place as follows:

Thursday, August 12	1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.	Eureka Room, Capitol Basement
Friday, August 13	1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.	Eureka Room, Capitol Basement
Sunday, August 15	10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.	Posey's Parking Garage*

\*Tests will be performed in a drive-thru setting at the Posey's parking garage while you remain in your vehicle. Posey's parking garage is located one block south from the State Capitol and across from the Secretary of State Building at 1517 11<sup>th</sup> Street, Sacramento, CA 95814. Please drive into the Posey's parking garage entrance on 11<sup>th</sup> Street. Staff will be posted at the entrance to guide you toward the testing station. Please do not enter using the 12<sup>th</sup> Street entrance, as that will be used solely for exiting the garage. These are rapid antigen tests and you will receive your results via text or email within 30 minutes.

## REQUIRED TESTING THROUGH THE END OF SESSION

Moving forward, <u>regardless of vaccination status</u>, <u>all essential employees who are</u> <u>supporting Floor Session and committee hearings must test twice per week through</u>

**the end of Session**. All unvaccinated staff coming to work in the Capitol or LOB must continue to test twice per week. Vaccinated staff who wish to test are also encouraged to do so.

Testing schedule during the last four (4) weeks of Session:

Mondays and Thursdays 7:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m. Eureka Room, Capitol Basement

OR

Tuesdays and Fridays 1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. Eureka Room, Capitol Basement

If you have not tested with Capitol Health Services in the past month, the link to register is: https://my.primary.health/l/assembly. You only need to register once (please use your Assembly email address and not your personal email address). After that, just drop in during testing hours, provide your name, show your Assembly ID badge, and be tested. You will receive your results via text or email within 30 minutes.
